It also brings forth the woman pirate as a metaphor for contemporary global issues of personal and social identity, cultural instability, immigration and hybridity, and reflects on the symbolism of the ship and its relevance to postcolonial discourse and, specifically, its relevance to contemporary and historical Australia.

#### **Pete Volich**

Exploring themes surrounding identity, representation and narrative structures, Volich focuses especially on everyday materials, scenarios and forms derived from the urban and suburban environment. The work mimics the framed sporting memorabilia commonly found in the ‘Games Room’ or ‘Sporting Club’. A collection of situations, memories and thoughts that are both real and imagined, are reconstructed using sporting memorabilia and found snap-shot photography that immortalise and frame a story or a moment in time.
